RE: NSAHO Pension Plan – 2009 Plan Maximums

In anticipation of the required changes to your payroll system for the upcoming 2009 year, this memo gives details on the various maximums that apply to the NSAHO Pension Plan, effective with the beginning pay period in 2009.

• CPP's Yearly Maximum Pensionable Earnings (YMPE)	\$ 46,300.00
• Maximum Pensionable Earnings applicable to our Plan	\$136,112.00
• Maximum Pension Benefit that can be earned for the Year	\$ 2,444.44
• Maximum Employee Contributions	\$ 11,162.02
• Maximum Employer Contributions (if Employer did not participate in ERIP*)	\$ 13,057.30
• Maximum Employer Contributions (if Employer participated in ERIP*)	\$ 13,873.98

* ERIP – Early Retirement Incentive Plan that was in place from 1994 to 1998.

Please note: The above Maximum Employee and Employer Contributions include a contribution increase which is expected to be effective April 1, 2009. Details regarding this increase are provided in Bulletin 2008-08.
